A DAY WITH THE LORD IN ADORATION

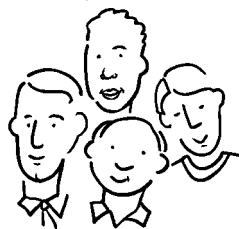
